ORDER

In the G O read as sixth paper above it was ordered that the UGC Scheme will be made applicable to teachers in Training Colleges and Law Colleges and to the qualified teachers in Physical Education and qualified Librarians working in Universities, professional colleges and Degree Colleges from 1-1-1986 as specified in the Annexure II of the said G O.

2 Government are now pleased to issue the following further orders regarding extension of UGC Scheme to qualified teachers in Physical Education and qualified Librarians working in Universities, professional colleges, and Degree Colleges etc., from 1-1-1986.

(1) Librarians and Physical Education Teachers coming under the UGC Scheme will not be entitled to benefits of pay revision by the State Government.

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(2) Their retirement age and retirement benefits will continue to be governed as per the existing rules in the State

(3) The arrears of salary due to them for the period from 1-1-1986 to 31-3-1990 will be deposited in the P.F. accounts of the employees concerned as per the provisions of Kerala State Government pay revision orders (G.O. (P) 480/89/Fin dated 1-11-1989

(4) All existing Assistant Librarians Grade II and above in the Universities and Librarians Grade I and above in Private Colleges affiliated to the Universities who were in service on or before 1-1-1986 and who possess the qualifications prescribed by the concerned Universities in Kerala and by Government in G.O. (P) No. 36/71/Edn dated 23-3-1971 and amendments issued thereunder, will be brought under the UGC Scheme in relaxation of qualifications prescribed by the UGC. They will also be given further placement after 8 or 16 years taking into account their service starting with Assistant Librarian Grade II in the case of Universities and Librarians Grade I in the case of Private Colleges affiliated to the Universities, subject to the conditions stipulated for such placement as contemplated in the UGC Scheme

(5) In the case of those persons who were holding the post of Library Assistant such as, Reference Assistant, Professional Assistant Grade I, Technical Assistant, Junior Librarian in Universities and Librarians Grade II in Private Colleges affiliated to the Universities and who were in the pre-revised scale of Rs. 1050-2000 or Rs 1100-2100 and who were in service on or before 1-4-1990 and who possess the qualifications prescribed by the UGC will be promoted as Assistant Librarian Grade II in Universities and Librarian Grade I in Private Colleges against open vacancies. The vacancies of Assistant Librarians Grade II/Librarian Grade I occurring in Universities and Private Colleges will be filled up in the ratio of 3:1 for promotion and direct recruitment as has been done in the case of college teachers

(6) In the State Service, the Librarians form a separate Pool and are attached to different departments like Education, Medical etc. But the UGC Scheme of revision will be applicable only to the Librarians in Arts & Science Colleges. As such before introduction of the UGC Scheme for Librarians in Government Colleges, a separate Library Science Service for Government Colleges, in the place of the existing pool system for Librarian, will be formulated comprising the senior persons in common pool, if necessary after obtaining their option for coming out of the common pool. Such persons alone will be posted as Librarian attached to Government Colleges and will be considered for inclusion in the UGC Scheme. Junior Librarians working in Government Colleges will be shifted to the places of Librarians in other departments under the common pool, vacated by the seniors, who have opted out of the pool. Such Junior Librarians will not be eligible for UGC Scales of pay. All existing Librarians Grade I and above in the common pool system under the State Service who were in service on or before 1-1-1986 and who possess the qualification prescribed by the concerned Universities

in Kerala and by Government in G.O. (P) No. 36/71/Edn dated 23-3-1971 and amendments issued thereunder and opt to come in the separate Library service to be formulated, will be brought under the UGC Scheme in relaxation of the qualification prescribed by UGC. They will be given further placement after 8 or 16 years taking into account their service starting with Assistant Librarian Grade I in the State Pool subject to the condition stipulated for such placement, as contemplated in the UGC Scheme

(7) Junior Librarians presently working in Government Colleges as well as other Junior Librarians in the State Common Pool who were holding the post of Librarian Grade II and who were in the pre-revised scale of Rs. 1050-2000 or Rs 1100-2100 and who were in service on or before 1-4-1990 and who possess the qualification prescribed by the UGC will be promoted as Librarian Grade I in Library Science Service for Government College against open vacancies. The vacancies of Librarian Grade I occurring in Library Science will be filled up in the ratio of 3:1 for promotion and direct recruitment as has been done in the case of college teachers

(8) The existing Assistant Directors of Physical Education and above in Universities, and Lecturer in Physical Education and above in colleges, who were in service on or before 1-1-1986 and who possess the qualifications prescribed by the Universities in Kerala or in the Special Rules issued by Government respectively, will be brought under UGC Scheme in relaxation of the qualifications prescribed by the UGC and they will be given career advancement as contemplated in the UGC Scheme. Further placement will be given to them after 8 or 16 years taking into account their service starting with Assistant Director of Physical Education in the case of Universities and Lecturer in Physical Education in the case of affiliated colleges subject to the conditions stipulated for such placement as contemplated in the UGC Scheme

(9) Other unqualified Assistant Director of Physical Education and Lecturer in Physical Education who were in service on or before 1-4-1990 as per the existing rules, will be brought under the UGC Scheme as and when they acquire the UGC qualifications and when there are open vacancies

(10) It is also clarified that the fixation of the number of posts of Physical Education teachers under UGC Scheme will be made only on the basis of student strength for degree and Post-Graduate classes in each college. The student strength in pre-degree classes will not be taken into account for this. Orders fixing the number of posts of Physical Education Teachers under UGC Scheme on the basis of student strength will be issued separately

3. The above Government orders, in so far as it relates to Universities, are subject to the final decision of the concerned universities
